## Fundraising Need:

Recreation Unlimited is the premier organization in the state of Ohio serving individuals, both youth and adults, with disabilities and health concerns through sports, recreation and education. Recreation Unlimited serves over 3,200 individuals with disabilities and health concerns on an annual basis through year-round camp programs. In support of the mission of Recreation Unlimited, we are requesting funds in support of Climbing Safety Equipment for the 50 ft. Alpine Tower II, specifically adapted for individuals with disabilities.

Climbing is a physically demanding activity that requires concentration, motor planning and sequential thought, among other skills. Full inclusion to accommodate individuals who have physical limitations or cognitive and sensory processing deficits is challenging, but at Recreation Unlimited we strive to meet those needs. The "On Belay... Climb Away!" request is to replace and upgrade safety equipment for the benefit of those who climb and those who help facilitate the climb on the 50 ft. Alpine Tower II.

The total project funds to be raised is \$8,000. Recreation Unlimited Foundation has secured \$4,000 to this project. Therefore, the total request through the Better Together program is an additional \$4,000. The expenses the funds will cover includes harnesses, helmets, carabiners, belay devices, rope, elbow and knee pads, hand holds, slings, and a few other miscellaneous support items.
