### One of a Kind Accessible and Inclusive Track Ride(s)

Recreation Unlimited is proud to announce that the Accessible and Universal Track Ride(s) was opened to our campers with disabilities on the night of July 17th at the annual Board, Family and Friends, Cookout and Fireworks Night at the Recreation Unlimited campus. This 2025 project is a 3,500 square foot Accessible and Inclusive Track Ride(s) that offers a unique ride (zip line), which is typically only an option for those without mobility challenges. The Track Ride(s) have two versions, for wheelchair and non-wheelchair users and can accommodate up to a 600lb weight limit. The Track Ride(s) gives campers the thrill of something exciting and new, with perceived risk and speed, while offering a new experience of elevated motion
